

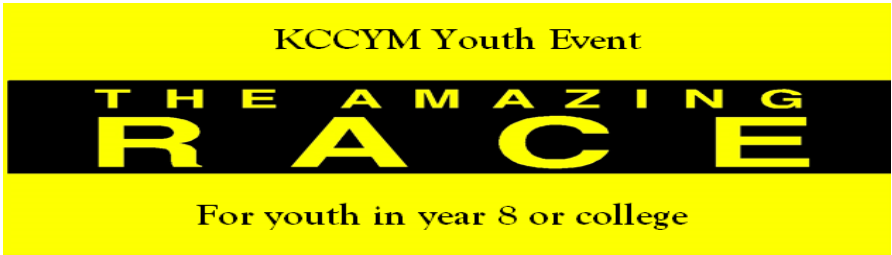

### The Return of the Duck aka The Duck is Back

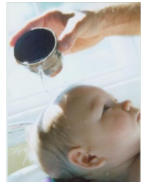

## MISSION GALA AND GARAGE SALE 2017

**SATURDAY 30 SEPTEMBER, 9 TO NOON, PARAPARAUMU MEMORIAL HALL**

Hello everyone, all supporters and friends. It is time to start thinking about and preparing for this year's mission Gala. This has been an annual event, widely supported by our Parish, its predecessor Parishes and the wider Kapiti community. However, for several reasons, this will be the last Gala to be run under current arrangements and management.

The Gala has been a wonderful and notable event for over 30 (possibly 35) years, and over that time has raised a lot of money to support our Presentation Sisters in their mission and social justice work in PNG, Chile and Ecuador, and, at times when there has been an extra special need, other works of the Sisters.

The first Gala result that I can find a record of was in 1985 which raised \$3,600; the last 10 years have averaged around \$ 17,000; and the total (without adjusting for inflation) is in the order of \$375,000 over 31 years. This has been a wonderfully generous contribution, especially when there have been and continue to be so many other demands on your generosity.

Previous letters and messages like this one have described many of the benefits provided by the Sisters' mission work, supported by us and others, but it can be summed up in the provision of pastoral, catechetical, medical and educational services. Even more importantly it has enabled these communities to grow in faith and wellbeing. There is now a cadre of educated and trained young local women in PNG able to care for their own people and to educate others and to become leaders in their communities. In the slum areas of Ecuador and Chile women have been enabled to establish small enterprises to support and educate their families. There is also Sr Breda's pride and joy, the health clinic, or Sik Haus, in Ningil, PNG, with trained nurses ministering to their own people. This work all follows the ideals and charism of the Sisters' Foundress, Nano Nagle.

While it is sad that this comes to an end, as all things must do, we can all be proud of what we have helped to achieve and we do want to remember and acknowledge the support and love of so many over so many years who have been involved in any way.

This will be our last opportunity to support the work of our Presentation Sisters in this way, so let's make it a great Gala, the best ever. We can do this by supporting the stall convenors with help, by contributing goods and useable items, and by coming along on the day to buy it all back (not your stuff, someone else's!!). Please keep this list handy for reference as the time of the Gala approaches.

Thank you, thank you - everyone - for all your generous support, prayers and love: and we know that you will continue this generosity in other ways.
