Welcome, family, greetings to you all. May the Lord be with you.

Dear Parishioners,

“For they did not yet understand the Scripture that he had to rise from the dead.” John 20:9

The apostles had lived with Jesus for years and had heard his numerous explanations about his mission and teachings. On at least three occasions, Jesus personally informed his disciples he would die and rise again. But when they encountered the empty tomb, where Jesus had been buried, they did not yet grasp the reality of the resurrection.

Today, on this Easter Sunday, with 2,000 years of resurrection theology woven into our religious teachings, we still are unable to fully understand this tremendous resurrection event. Jesus had raised the dead like the widow's son and also his friend, Lazarus, but in the case of Jesus himself, we need to note the difference between resurrection and restoration. Lazarus was restored to his former life, to die again; but in resurrection, Jesus rose to a new and glorified life - never more to die.

We share our Easter joy with the victory of Jesus, a promise of eternal life - our precious heritage.
