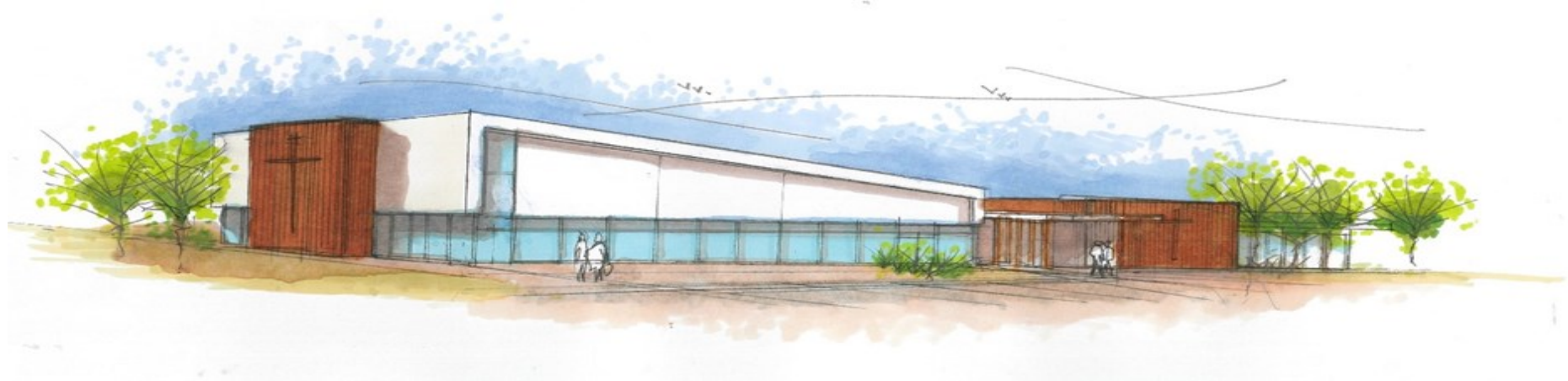

Delivered by the fabulous Gilbert Haismann.

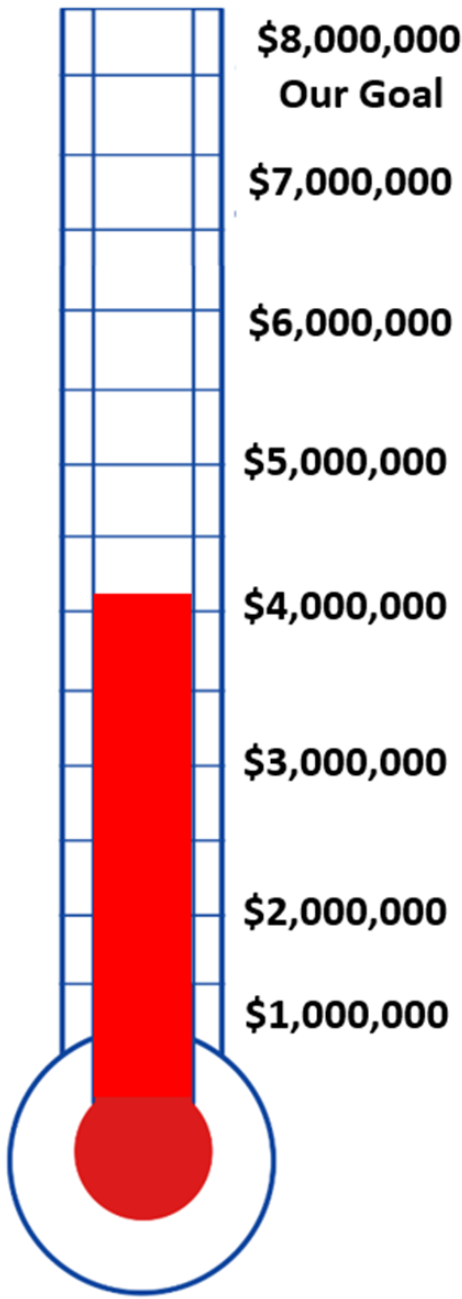

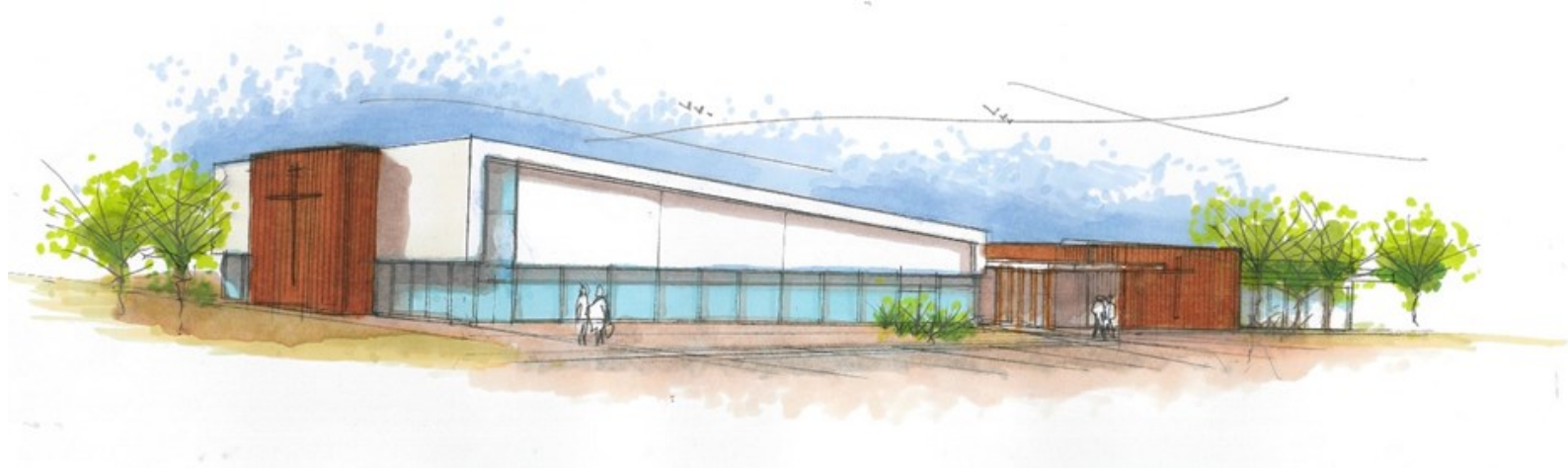
